

Martha and Tom felt they needed to help but should do it anonymously. They bought a gift voucher from a local food store and posted it to her with no return address. They asked a friend to write the address on the envelope so she wouldn't recognize the handwriting. They posted it from another town so the postal stamp was unknown.

Four years later, also at Christmas time, Martha decided to tell her friend who the gift was from. When she did, her friend just smiled and said from that Christmas on, she had been helping others who are in need every Christmas.

It just goes to show you how a little act of kindness can have a big ripple effect.
